Agenda Item	Main points of discussion	when and who
Andy Thompson	<p>Andy explained to the council that he wants to find out their thoughts on a possible new community centre and whether they think having a youth facility in the centre would be good. There is also an option of a specific young person’s gym. Andy had provided a questionnaire previous to the meeting which was given to each form – 5 had been returned before the meeting. Other members said they had not received this questionnaire in form.</p> <p>Students had been asked to speak to their forms before this meeting and provide Andy with feedback:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students would like a place to socialise – comfy chairs • A pool table, console and other activities would be good • A lot of positive feedback about the gym – a lot of students said they would use this facility • A number of forms said it’s a good idea but they wouldn’t use it. • Students wouldn’t want to pay much to enter <p>The council discussed the fact that the school will also have a new gym – some members felt that students wouldn’t want to use this out of school time as it’s in the school, also it would be good to have a gym specifically for young people.</p> <p>Students filled in questionnaires which were returned to Andy.</p> <p>Andy asked if students have any more feedback to let Miss Kench know.</p>	
Breakfast club	<p>Miss Kench explained that the Healthy Schools group has discussed the possibility of having a Breakfast club held in the Infozone in the mornings. The reason behind using the Infozone is that it is a place with consoles, games and a TV that could be used by students before school starts. Cereal, toast and juices could be available for students to use.</p> <p>Miss Kench asked for feedback to this idea - students filled in a short questionnaire – The results will be shared next meeting.</p> <p>Miss Kench asked for students to ask their forms what they think about this idea.</p>	Next meeting

<p>Pre order Grab and Go</p>	<p>Miss Kench explained that the Healthy Schools group has been planning a new Pre order lunch system which would enable students and staff to order and pay a variety of cold meal deals before school starts, and then collect the meal during the first 10minutes of lunch. This should hopefully reduce the queues during lunch time. Students thought this was a very good idea and think it should be popular and reduce queues.</p> <p>Miss Kench asked what the council thinks about students volunteering to hand out the deals during the first 10minutes of lunch:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Would want a reward – not Vivo miles. • A free lunch would be a good reward • The group agreed that once you’ve volunteered 3-4 times you should get the reward. • You would need 2 or more students to hand out the meals • If a lot of students volunteered they wouldn’t have to do it often – maybe once a week. • Prefects would not be able to do as they already have a lot of things to do. • 7 of the council members said that they would volunteer <p>The Council are going to ask their forms for feedback/volunteers.</p>	<p>Next meeting</p>
