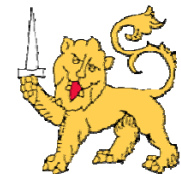

- Selection day

Qualification

- City and Guilds Diploma in Hairdressing
- Application of Functional Skills in English and Maths
- First Aid
- 50 days work placement – on the shop floor
